SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. Applicant must be either a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative member or under 21 years of age and a legal dependent of a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative member.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in either a 2 or 4-year degree program at an accredited institution in Illinois.
3. Applicant cannot have previously received a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative scholarship.
4. Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative employees, directors, and any of their dependents are ineligible.
5. Total of six (6) \$500 scholarships will be awarded. Priority will be given to one applicant who is specializing in Electrical Engineering.
