SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND RULES

Objective: Provide six \$500 scholarships and one \$1,000 scholarship for financial assistance to eligible cooperative member applicants.

- 1 Applicant must be either a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative (CMEC) member or under 21 years of age and a legal dependent of a Coles-Moultrie Electric Cooperative member.
- 2 Applicant must be enrolled in 2 or 4 year degree program at an accredited institution including vocational/technical schools and will be judged based on academics, volunteer/community involvement, written essay and neatness of application.
- 3 Applicant cannot have previously received a CMEC scholarship.
- 4 CMEC employees, directors and their dependents are ineligible.
- 5 Please email a jpg photo to: cbradbury@cmeccoop (can be a senior picture).
- 6 Proof of college enrollment to CMEC is required before the scholarship funds will be awarded.
- 7 **Notification:** Recipients will be notified in May and will be invited to attend CMEC's Annual Meeting.

- 9 CMEC will select one recipient for the Randall Beasley Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000). Preference will be given to an individual attending lineman school or majoring in the electrical or engineering field of study.
